



Application to become a Registered Patent Agent

In accordance with The Registered Patents and Biotechnological Inventions
(Bailiwick of Guernsey) Regulations 2012

Any application or submission regarding a patent in the Bailiwick of Guernsey must be carried out by a Registered Patent Agent* **unless** the application or submission is undertaken by a person who is:

1. ordinarily resident in the Bailiwick but does not yet have a patent registered here (i.e. they wish to register a granted patent); or
2. ordinarily resident in the Bailiwick and has a patent registered here

The Registrar keeps and maintains a register of patent agents having assessed an application from a qualifying person(s) and payment of the relevant fee. All agents, as well as meeting the qualifying persons criteria (see below), must also be ordinarily resident in the Bailiwick of Guernsey and have a business address in the Bailiwick.

The interpretation of business address includes a place of business taking account of staff, premises and taxes paid in the Bailiwick.

Qualifying persons are as follows:

1. An Advocate;
2. A person whose name is entered on the register of patent attorneys under the Copyright, Designs and Patents Act 1988;
3. A Corporate Service Provider (as described in the Companies (Guernsey) Law, 2008);
4. Such person who, by reason of qualifications or experience, the Registrar determines to be a fit and proper person to act as an Agent for others under the Registered Patents and Biotechnological Inventions (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Ordinance, 2009

In addition to the registration fee there is also an annual renewal fee which is due on or before the 31 December in each year. Please see the separate fee schedule for details of the registration and renewal fee—www.guernseyregistry.com.ip

* The Regulations refer to Patent Attorneys—these are designated as Agents by the Registrar for the purposes of representing applications to the Registry
