Trade Marks: Registrar Rules on Fees

These Rules are made pursuant to The Trade Marks (Fees) Regulations, 2010 (the “Regulations”).

Rule 1:

Pursuant to sections 4(1) and (2) of the Regulations:

The Registrar may:

- (a) waive payment of the fee, as detailed in the fees schedule, for registration of a single Trade Mark, in one nice class, by the following applicants;
 - a. businesses which are shortlisted for the 2015 Bill Green Award for Entrepreneurial Spirit, and subsequent years; and
 - b. businesses which are shortlisted for the 2015 Awards for Achievement, and subsequent years.

- (b) offer reduced fees for Trade Mark registrations at industry or Registry organised events where event attendees submit an application to the Registry within one month of the event. This offer will only apply where the event organiser has entered into agreement with the Registrar, prior to the event taking place.

The Registrar has consulted with the Department on these Rules, and the Department has confirmed its approval.
